



**Juniors playing in Senior Men's A or B, or Women's Summer Competition 2016**

**Parental Consent: To be signed by Parent/ Guardian** on behalf of a junior who is seeking permission to play with a Senior Competition (according to the criteria for juniors to play in the senior competitions as per Competition Guidelines.

**BBBA is committed to the provision of a safe and inclusive environment for all. It is aware of its obligations to the law as it relates to children (under 18).**

As such it is mandatory for the Senior Competition Committee to undertake a risk assessment for each competition, and that if necessary to do another one with adjustments in the case of injury, or a Child Protection incident. For example abuse of any kind e.g. verbal, physical, psychological, including harassment (which can be a single incident) is against the law as it pertains to children (under 18). As is any other breach of the Child Protection Act as per the Member Protection By-Law adopted by BBBA.
